FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry to Watergate Bay Sprint, to be held on Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 September 2023.

Please ensure you have read the event supplementary regulations, these final instructions and any further correspondence issued by the Event Secretary or Entries Secretary in full. Please familiarise yourself with the attached site plan.

The Noticeboard, Results and Awards presentation will be at the Hawkins Hospitality Unit (Event HQ) in the main paddock area. Catering and Toilets are nearby.

Please refer to the attached entry list for your competition number.

Please see attached draft batch running order. This is subject to change. The final batch running order will be posted on the noticeboard.

It would be helpful if you could complete a [competitor information form](#) for the commentators. It may avoid the roving paddock commentator from chasing you through the paddock with a microphone, but there are no guarantees.

TRAVEL

The paddock is located in the Boardmasters Festival Field near Trebelzue Farm, TR8 4AA on the B3276 between Porth and Watergate Bay. The paddock will be accessible for early arrivals from 12:00 on Friday 15 September.

If arriving at the venue on Saturday and/or Sunday morning please only approach from the Watergate Bay direction via Trevarrian (turning from the B3276 near the Travellers Rest pub (postcode TR8 4AJ, [///version.breakfast.film](#)) otherwise you will be met with a road closure and will need to follow the sign-posted diversion route. There will be green arrows to assist you.

There will be no vehicular access to the paddock for anyone arriving before 06:00 or after 08:30 on Saturday and Sunday.

Please be aware that you will be passing homes and hotels on the way to the venue so please drive with care and courtesy.

PADDOCK AND PARKING

The paddock area is located in a grass field. Each paddock space is 8mx8m and identified in the rear left hand corner by your competition number. Please park support vehicles / motorhomes etc to the rear of your space and your competition vehicle at the front to ensure good visibility for the paddock marshal and officials. Do not encroach on adjoining paddock spaces.

Any friends and family accompanying you must arrive by 08:30 when the paddock entrance is closed. Parties arriving late will need to park in the spectator car park and pay the spectator entry fee.

You are responsible for the paddock surface under your vehicles including tow cars and motorhomes etc.

Take care when refuelling in the paddock. Non-metal fuel containers are permitted. Fuel containers should be stored away appropriately between refuelling.

There are 4 fire point trolleys located in the paddock area.

You are reminded that the paddock is open to spectators throughout the event and at times it's likely to be busy. Personal items are left in the paddock at your own risk.

VENUE

Competition cars may be left in the paddock overnight entirely at your own risk.

Overnight camping on Friday and Saturday is permitted in the paddock. Please ensure that you bring your own water supply as water is not available at the venue. The use of disposable BBQs is not permitted due to fire risk in the grass paddock.

All generators must be switched off by 22:00 and noise kept to a minimum after this time.

Event toilets will be located around the paddock and a grey waste disposal unit sited along the hedge line. Please do not allow your waste to spill onto the grass. The field will have sheep back in on Tuesday.

Take your litter home. Please leave the paddock as you found it.

We will have a number of catering facilities available over the weekend. Hot food and drinks will be available from 07:00 on both Saturday and Sunday.

Please note that **dogs are not permitted** in any part of the venue and this is strictly observed. Dogs found on site put the future of the venue at risk.

The flying of drones is prohibited in all areas of the site including the paddock, car parks, display and spectator areas.

Security will be patrolling the sprint area between 22:00 and 05:00 on Friday and Saturday.

Electric Vehicles: Charging of electric vehicles onsite is strictly prohibited.

COMPETITOR INFORMATION AND SIGNING ON

Competitor signing on will be at Event HQ from 07:00 until 08:30 each day. Competition licences and membership cards must be presented on both days.

All retirements from competition after signing on must be notified to the Entries Secretary.

A drivers' briefing will be held each day at 08:30 at Event HQ. It is mandatory for all drivers to attend, including those taking demonstration runs.

SCRUTINEERING AND NOISE TEST

A pre-event scrutineering session will be held between 17:00 and 19:00 on Friday 15th September at the scrutineering location indicated on the site plan. This session will be on a first come, first served basis. Any competition cars undergoing Friday night scrutineering must thereafter remain on site or be subject to re-scrutineering.

All Saturday and Sunday scrutineering will be in your allocated paddock space between 07:00 and 08:45. Competitors in batches 1-3 are required to present their cars for scrutineering by 08:00.

Noise testing will be conducted in the batch assembly area in the main paddock in advance of practice runs.

EVENT

We encourage all competitors to take the opportunity to walk the course after the road closure at 06:00 but please be mindful of the presence of course vehicles involved with set up. There will be a tractor and trailer assisting with the location of straw bales. Please note that it will be dark until approximately 07:00.

Practice runs will commence at 09:00 each day.

Batches will be assembled in the designated assembly area. Please make sure you are aware of the batch number you have been allocated and be ready to move to the assembly area when the paddock marshal calls for you.

When you enter the assembly area please adhere to the marshals instructions to avoid any delays. As you approach the paddock exit to enter the track do not pass the "Wait Here" sign until called for, to avoid blocking the exit for any course vehicles that may need access to the track.

Once your batch is assembled and the prior batch has returned to the paddock, all cars in your batch will be released to convoy to the pre-start paddock.

Please note that tyre warming is not allowed. This includes on the convoy to the pre-start paddock, within the pre-start paddock or at the start line.

On completion of your timed run, slow to 15mph, enter the paddock field and make your way back to your paddock space.

AWARDS

The awards presentation will take place as soon as possible following completion of the timed runs on each day, at Event HQ.

Saturday awards will be presented by Pirate FM's Lucy Start.

Sunday awards will be presented by Cornwall Councillor Louis Gardner.
