### **Awards**

The awards presentation will take place as soon as possible following conclusion of the timed runs on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> September.

### **Travel**

If arriving at the venue on Saturday and/or Sunday morning please only approach the venue from the Watergate Bay direction via Trevarrian (turning from the B3276 near the Travellers Rest Pub Postcode TR8 4AJ, ///version,breakfast,film) otherwise you will be met with a road closure and you will need to follow the sign posted diversion route, There will be green arrows to assist you. There will be no access to the paddock after 08-30 hrs. Please be aware you will be passing homes and hotels on the way to the paddock so please drive with care and courtesy.

### **Paddock and Parking**

Only your tow vehicle, trailer and competition car will be allowed to enter the paddock area. If you have friends travelling in other vehicles please make sure they use the spectator car park which is operated independently of the sprint organisers for which there will be a small charge of £4 per day. They can access the paddock on foot using the spectator entrance for which they will be charged £12 per person ( children under 14 free). Please do not attempt to get extra friends or families into the paddock as space is limited and you have an allocated area.

If you have a Campervan, Motorhome or Caravan which is separate to your tow vehicle please make sure the organisers are aware of this beforehand. A numbered 8x8 metre space is available which should accommodate your competition vehicle and one other. If extra space is required trailers can be parked against the fence separating the paddock from the spectator car park. Security of your equipment in the paddock is your responsibility.

Overnight camping on Friday and Saturday nights with campervan, motorhome, caravan or tent is permitted only in the paddock area.

**Please ensure you bring enough water for personal and vehicle requirements as there is no water available on site.**

**For the comfort of all campers the use of generators after 21-30 hrs is not permitted.**

**The use of disposable barbeques is not permitted.**

**Dogs are not permitted anywhere on site.**

Toilets are available in various areas and in particular along with Elsan (Black Waste) facility are adjacent to the competitor parking area. Please do not allow grey waste to spill on the grass as the area will be grazed by sheep after the event. Please use the black bags provided for your refuse as items such as food wrappers have been known to cause fatalities to farm animals.

Caterers will be providing food on the Friday evening and throughout the weekend in the main spectator area. Hot food will be available from 07-30hrs.

Competitors are asked to read the ASR's and associated Health and Safety document. Particular attention is drawn to proper storage of fuel and care of children. Non metal fuel containers are permitted. There will be 4 fire point trolleys located in the paddock area.

Competitors who are not staying overnight may leave their car in the paddock area at their own risk.

The flying of drones anywhere on site is not permitted as the area is within the no fly area of Newquay Airport and also MSUK rules prohibit it.

Please make sure you bring the correct competition licences and club membership cards with you and be prepared to present these to the event secretary when signing on. You will be provided with event decals which should be affixed on each side of your competition vehicle. You will also be given a black refuse sack which along with the refuse in it should be taken home with you.

You will be responsible for the surface under your vehicles including tow cars which is grass in all areas and we recommend the use of a tarpaulin under your competition car.

Signing on will be at the Hawkins Hospitality Unit from 07-30 hrs.

Scrutineering will be available Friday evening from 19-30 to 21-00 hrs at the space provided near the double entry gates.

Scrutineering on Saturday and Sunday will be in your allocated space so please make sure you are available for the scrutineer.

Sound level testing will take place in the batch assembly area.

## **The Sprint**

We would encourage you to walk the course after the road closure at 06-00 hrs but be aware that setting up will still be taking place and official vehicles and farm vehicles will be moving about on the course distributing and siting straw bales. Note it will be dark until approximately 07-00 hrs.

For the running of the Saturday and Sunday schedules all competitors will be split into batches and assembled in the main paddock area. Please make sure you check the batch running order and be ready when called by the paddock marshal and obey their instructions to ensure the running order. Do not pass the wait here sign until instructed as official vehicles may need access to the course. Vehicles will proceed in convoy to the start holding area. At all times you are on the course all safety equipment must be worn. No tyre warming is allowed. At completion of your run slow to 10 mph to enter the paddock and proceed to your allocated space.

## **Local Information**

Watergate Bay has bars, restaurants, cafes, shops, public toilets, surf schools and public car parks. Early booking for restaurants is advised as spaces are limited.
